Prevention/ Early Intervention



Grades K-3

Foundations® Virtual Launch Workshops provide the practice and guidance needed to begin teaching the Foundations curriculum for the selected workshop Level. Led by a skilled instructor, each interactive remote workshop addresses: the principles of instruction; skills taught in the selected Foundations Level, including phonemic awareness and the alphabetic principle, phonics and word study, vocabulary, high frequency words, fluency, comprehension, handwriting, and spelling; daily learning plan development; practice of lesson activities; and use of the Teacher's Manual/other resources.

Foundations® is a Structured Literacy program for Grades K-3 that is grounded in the science of reading and Orton-Gillingham principles. It provides Tier 1 instruction and Tier 2 intervention within a Response to Intervention/Multi-tiered System of Supports. It thoroughly teaches the foundational literacy skills of the North Carolina English Language Arts Standards (print concepts, phonological awareness, phonics, word recognition, and fluency). It also supports reading, writing, and language standards.

Grades 4-12 & Adults

Just Words® Virtual Launch Workshops provide the practice and guidance needed to begin teaching the Just Words curriculum. Led by a skilled instructor, this interactive remote workshop addresses: the principles of instruction; skills taught, including word study, vocabulary, high frequency words, spelling, and fluency; appropriate identification/grouping of students; daily learning plan development; practice of lesson activities; and use of the Instructor Manual/other resources.

Grounded in the science of reading, Just Words® is a word-level Structured Literacy intervention program (Tier 2) for students who need additional support learning to read and spell at grade level. Explicit, systematic, cumulative, highly interactive, and data driven, Just Words focuses on decoding and spelling at an accelerated pace. The program is appropriate for students in Grades 4-12 and adults with mild-to-moderate gaps in decoding and spelling proficiency who do not require intensive intervention. It features the progression of the six English syllable types and morphological patterns of prefixes, common Latin roots, and suffixes. Use in daily small-group or small-class instruction.

Grades 2-12 & Adults

Wilson Reading System® (WRS) Introductory Courses provide an overview of the Wilson Reading System Fourth Edition curriculum and serve as the prerequisite for WRS Level I Certification, which makes one eligible for the Wilson® Dyslexia Practitioner (W.D.P.) credential. Currently offered in a virtual, instructor-led format, this course addresses: the process of identifying appropriate students; WRS principles of instruction; and an introduction to the systematic, explicit, and integrated instruction in phonology, morphology, and orthography.

The Wilson Reading System® is an intensive (Tier 3) multisensory structured language education (MSLE) program for students in Grade 2 and beyond who have a language-based learning disability, such as dyslexia, or who have not internalized the sound-symbol system for reading and spelling. Grounded in the science of reading and Orton-Gillingham principles, WRS is a highly structured remedial program that teaches the structure of English. (One optional graduate credit is available through Fitchburg State University, Fitchburg, MA.)
